

EU Declaration of Conformity No. AP-KAD-MW-PPWR-DoC-001

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR)

This declaration of conformity provides the consolidated conformity statement for the standardised transport and protective packaging used for MULTICLEAR® multiwall polycarbonate sheets under Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR).

Arla Plast s.r.o. manufactures extruded multiwall polycarbonate sheets. The sheets themselves are not the object of this packaging declaration. The standardised transport and protective packaging used for their shipment is within the scope of the PPWR.

We hereby formally confirm:

- Fulfilment of the requirements laid down in or pursuant to Articles 5 to 12 that apply to packaging type MW-KAD-TR-01 has been demonstrated, including compliance with the 100 mg/kg maximum combined concentration of lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg) and hexavalent chromium (Cr(VI)) under Article 5(4).
- Structural and material data, together with supporting technical documentation required for the conformity assessment, are maintained under Annex VII and are subject to controlled change management.

3. This declaration of conformity is issued under the sole responsibility of the manufacturer.

4. Object of the declaration (identification of the packaging allowing traceability):

Description of the packaging:

Single-use industrial transport and protective packaging system designed for MULTICLEAR® multiwall polycarbonate sheets. Depending on the controlled packing configuration, the system may consist of:

- Primary / Protective Layer: protective PE/LDPE films and, where applicable, temporary PE/LDPE edge/transport tapes and non-adhesive printed identification strips.
- Secondary / Grouping Layer: corrugated-board protection, paper-based edge protectors, bubble film, adhesive packaging tape (BOPP film + adhesive) and PP strapping/banding, where applicable.
- Tertiary / Transport Layer: timber supports or pallets dimensioned according to sheet size, handling and transport requirements.

Only packaging configurations expressly defined in Arla Plast Packing Specification AP-KAD-MW-PACK-001, Rev. 01, and related controlled packing instructions linked to MW-KAD-TR-01 are covered by this declaration.

5. The object of this declaration referred to point 4 is in conformity with the relevant Union harmonisation legislation:

- Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 December 2024 on packaging and packaging waste.

6. References to the relevant harmonised standards or the common specifications used or references to the other technical specifications in relation to which conformity is declared:

- EN 13427:2004 - Packaging - Requirements for the use of European Standards in the field of packaging and packaging waste.
- EN 13428:2004 - Packaging - Requirements specific to manufacturing and composition - Prevention by source reduction.
- EN 13430:2004 - Packaging - Requirements for packaging recoverable by material recycling.
- Arla Plast Packing Specification AP-KAD-MW-PACK-001, Rev. 01, and related controlled packing instructions applicable to MW-KAD-TR-01.

7. Where applicable, notified body performed and issued the certificate(s):

Not applicable. The conformity assessment is carried out under Annex VII, Module A (internal production control); notified-body involvement is not required for this conformity assessment.

8. Additional information:

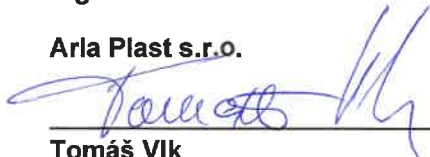

The PPWR contains additional requirements with later application dates and requirements for which relevant secondary legislation, delegated or implementing acts and harmonised standards are not yet available. The necessary assessments and information will be incorporated into the controlled technical documentation no later than the respective application dates.

Relevant technical documentation is kept available for competent national authorities in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2025/40. Changes that may affect conformity are subject to internal change control and reassessment.
