

Declaration of Conformity Nr AB-268001
Packaging Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

This declaration of conformity provides our data consolidation for the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR - Regulation (EU) 2025/40):

As a manufacturer of extruded plastic sheets, our core products fall outside the scope of the PPWR. However, our standardised transport and protective packaging used to ship our materials (wooden pallets, protective cardboard liners, masking films, plastic strapping, custom or special packaging) are within the scope of the PPWR.

We hereby formally confirm:

- Compliance with the 100 mg/kg (ppm) maximum heavy metal threshold (lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium) under Article 5 of the PPWR
- Collection of structural data required for our technical documentation files under Annex VII.

1. Unique identification of the packaging:

3. This declaration of conformity is issued under the sole responsibility of the manufacturer.

4. Object of the declaration (identification of the packaging allowing traceability):

Description of the packaging:

Single-use industrial transport and protection packaging system designed for custom-sized extruded plastic sheets, consisting of:

- Primary/Protective Layer: Polyethylene (PE) masking surface protection film applied directly to the extruded sheets, where applicable.
- Secondary/Grouping Layer: Corrugated cardboard sheets (top and bottom protective dividers), cardboard corner protections, wrapped in a structural Polyethylene (PE) stretch wrap film with stabilising plastic/metal tension straps.
- Tertiary/Transport Layer: Non-standard, custom-dimensioned single-use wooden pallets (typically 2 x 3 meters or adapted dimensions based on sheet size specifications), manufactured in Sweden.

5. The object of this declaration referred to point 4 is in conformity with the relevant Union harmonisation legislation:

- Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR), amending and replacing Directive 94/62/EC.
- Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH) regarding concentration restrictions of heavy metals and hazardous substances in packaging materials.

6. References to the relevant harmonised standards or the common specifications used or references to the other technical specifications in relation to which conformity is declared:

- EN 13428:2004 – Packaging - Specific requirements for manufacturing and composition - Prevention by source reduction (Justifying the custom 2x3m+ pallet size to optimise structural protection and minimise empty space during transport).
- EN 13430:2004 – Packaging - Requirements for packaging recoverable by material recycling (Applied directly to certify the material recycling capability of the single-use PE masking, PE wrap, and corrugated cardboard layers).
- EN 13427:2004 – Packaging - Requirements for the use of European Standards in the field of packaging and packaging waste.
- ISPM 15 – International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures No. 15 (Heat-treatment and phytosanitary rules for wood packaging, executed and stamped by a certified Swedish manufacturer under the supervision of the Swedish Board of Agriculture), where applicable.
- Commission Delegated Decision (EU) 2026/429 – Supplementing Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council by exempting certain economic operators that use pallet wrappings and straps from the 100% reuse requirements of these packaging formats.

7. Where applicable, notified body performed and issued the certificate(s):

Not applicable (Conformity established via internal production control and structural self-declaration supported by supplier material safety data sheets).

8. Additional information:

All structural components are chosen to minimise environmental weight ratios while maintaining safety. The single-use PE films and corrugated cardboards are designed to be recyclable through appropriate industrial recycling streams. Custom Swedish pallets are sourced from sustainable forests, heat-treated in accordance with ISPM 15, and declared under single-use compliance channels.

Our packaging materials are free from intentionally added PFAS.

The PPWR contains additional requirements for which the relevant secondary legislation and harmonised standards are not yet available. We will provide the necessary information in due time, but no later than upon the entry into force of the respective legal acts.
